

Vehement opposition to Public Security Bill

Dhamangaon Railway 10 September (NAGPUR POST/TC): On behalf of Dhamangaon Railway taluka Maha Vikas Aghadi, a group of protestors led by former legislator Virendra Jagtap, agitated at the Tehsil Office to voice their concerns over the unjust Public Security Bill. Maharashtra is a progressive state and its residents believe in progressive thinking based on the principle of Shahu Phule Ambedkar ideology. In Maharashtra, the Mahayuti government has passed the Public Security Bill in the legislative assembly and the bill shall be sent to the Governor soon for his consent & signature. Due to this bill, this government shall get a free run and the leaders of the regime will be able to freely target political opponents, social organisations, journalists who take an anti-government stance. Those who do not agree with the government's stance on various issues of state and national importance will be trapped through this law and this would lead to the ending of democracy. This is an attempt to snatch the rights of the common people who try to express their opinions through the principles propagated by the Constitution. If social organisations, political parties, or opposition coalitions take an anti-government stance, their members will be charged with crimes. They will be liable to face action without any consideration of justice. Suspects under this law will be imprisoned and their properties confiscated. Therefore, one will not even be able to get bail under this law and a long legal tussle will have to be waged in court. This is a black law that the state government wants to follow. We have no objection to using such a law in the case of Naxalite activities

and anti-national terrorists, but if someone is protesting and pointing out the shortcomings of the government then such acts should not be considered as heinous crimes. This trend can be dangerous from the point of view of a healthy democracy. A detailed review of the bill passed in the 2025 session of Maharashtra legislative assembly has been conducted. A committee was recently formed to invite objections and suggestions on the bill. A total of 12750 objections and suggestions were received by the committee, out of which more than 9500 suggestions advocated the repealing of the bill. Therefore, a memorandum has been submitted to the Governor and the Chief Minister through the Tehsildar to express opposition to this draconian law on behalf of the constituent parties of MVA coalition in Dhamangaon Railway taluka. Weaver bird building its nest is indeed a sight for all and sundry to behold



Nandgaon Khandeshwar 10 September (Uttam Brahmanwade): 'Oh, the swiftlet in the hollow is a good omen; she hung it on a tree for her chicks perhaps.' As per this saying, when the rainy season starts, the swiftlet bird, or the weaver bird gets engrossed in building its nests. These nests, which hang on the branches of thorny acacia trees or tall trees, are mesmerising to look at from afar. The weaver bird designs its nests with special skill to protect the chicks from heat, rain, enemy birds or snakes. Some nests are long and some are rather short. While swinging in the wind, it seems as if a cradle is hanging in the sky. Often, the entire colony of swiftlet birds or weaver birds can be seen in a tree. These nests, tightly tied to the branches, remain safe even amid storms and rains. Seeing this art of nest building, the bird seems to be like an engineer of the aviation world.

These nests are usually built on trees like tamarind, lemon, karanja, banyan, khair etc, which are usually located on the banks of wells, streams, and drains. The male bird builds the nest and shows it to the female. If the female does not like it, he builds another nest. The male bird has a dark yellow body and black head, while the female is pale yellow in colour. The female lays about 4 to 5 eggs. The chicks of the sugar glider do not fly until they are fully strong. However, due to the increasing concrete jungle and rapid process of deforestation, the number of such nests is decreasing by leaps and bounds. Still, in many places in rural areas, such nests can still be seen perched on trees.

Young woman drowns in water while trying to take out Aarti plate

Daryapur 10 September (Mahesh Bunde): An unfortunate incident took place during Ganesh idol immersion procession in Daryapur town on the day of Anant Chaturdashi. A young woman who had gone for the immersion rituals drowned in water and died as a result. The name of the deceased young woman is Mukta Sahebkhola Shrinath (aged 32 years, resident of Barabkhol, Daryapur). She had gone for Ganesh Visarjan rituals in the Chandrabhaga river basin. While trying to take out the Aarti plate during the immersion rituals, she was suddenly swept away by the river current. With the help of local citizens, she was immediately taken out

and admitted to the hospital for treatment. However, the doctors examined her and declared her dead. This incident has resulted in Mukta's family descending into a pall of gloom. With no fatherly or guardian like figure, her kin are reeling under crisis. A demand for extending financial assistance has been put forth before the administration by sympathetic locals. This incident has resulted in Daryapur residents descending into a pall of gloom. Her last rites were performed in an atmosphere of mourning on Sunday morning. She is survived by her mother and a disabled younger brother.

Postal Department's Savings Festival Campaign underway
